Kathleen and Bill Christison: Bill Christison was a senior official in the CIA. Kathleen Christison is a former CIA analyst and is the author of *Perceptions of Palestine: Their Influence of US Policy*.

The Rev Naim Ateek: founder and leader of Sabeel; known as the 'Bishop Tutu of Palestine,' former canon of the Episcopal Cathedral Jerusalem, author of *A Palestinian Christian Cry for Reconciliation*.

Mark Braverman: American-Jewish activist, founder of Crisis Management Group Associates in Maryland, author of *Fatal Embrace: Christians, Jews and the Search for Peace in the Holy Land*.

Steve Niva: professor of International Political Science at The Evergreen State College. Focusing on the Middle East, he is a frequent contributor to journals and newspapers.

Jeff Halper: Israeli-American peace activist, coordinator of Israeli Committee Against House Demolitions (ICAHAD), 2006 Nobel Prize nominee. Author of *A Reframing of the Palestinian-Israeli Conflict and An Israeli in Palestine*.

Cindy and Craig Corrie: parents of Rachel Corrie, founders of the Rachel Corrie Foundation for Peace and Justice.

Tom Nelson: co-founder of Americans United for Palestinian Human Rights, practicing attorney with a focus on international law, specifically the investigation of possible war crimes in Gaza.
