Jeff Halper: Israeli-American peace activist, coordinator of Israeli Committee Against House Demolitions (ICAHD), 2006 Nobel Prize nominee. Author of A Reframing of the Palestinan-Israeli Conflict and An Israeli in Palestine.

Steve Niva: professor of International Political Science at The Evergreen State College. Focusing on the Middle East, he is a frequent contributor to journals and newspapers.

Cindy and Craig Corrie: parents of Rachel Corrie, founders of the Rachel Corrie Foundation for Peace and Justice.

Tom Nelson: co-founder of Americans United for Palestinian Human Rights, practicing attorney with a focus on international law, specifically the investigation of possible war crimes in Gaza.
