**Mark Braverman:** American-Jewish activist, founder of Crisis Management Group Associates in Maryland, author of *Fatal Embrace: Christians, Jews and the Search for Peace in the Holy Land*.

**Steve Niva:** professor of International Political Science at The Evergreen State College. Focusing on the Middle East, he is a frequent contributor to journals and newspapers.

**Jeff Halper:** Israeli-American peace activist, coordinator of Israeli Committee Against House Demolitions (ICAHD), 2006 Nobel Prize nominee. Author of *A Reframing of the Palestinian-Israeli Conflict* and *An Israeli in Palestine*.

**Cindy and Craig Corrie:** parents of Rachel Corrie, founders of the Rachel Corrie Foundation for Peace and Justice.

**Tom Nelson:** co-founder of Americans United for Palestinian Human Rights; practicing attorney with a focus on international law, specifically the investigation of possible war crimes in Gaza.
